## Principal's Report

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you so much to the parents/carers that have been able to fill out and return the 'Parent Teacher Meeting Survey'. We have once again had a good response rate. In the coming weeks staff will have the opportunity to analyse and consider the feedback, which we look forward to sharing with the whole school community.

I also wanted to take this opportunity to thank the parents that reminded me of the fact that we have established a culture at the school where parents are more than welcome to organise a meeting to catch up with their child's teacher at any time throughout the year. Thank you also to the parents that shared ideas and suggestions!

### Curriculum Day

Reminder that there is no school for students tomorrow, Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> of June 2017. On this day, the teachers will be working together to prepare midyear reports for parents.

### Enrolments for 2018

Thank you to the families that have enrolled a sibling in Prep for 2018. We have reached our school capacity in terms of student enrolments, which is a nice thing, but also a challenge in terms of predicting enrolment numbers for the coming years. Due to us reaching our enrolment capacity, we will need to further reduce the number of families that enrol at the school that reside outside of our boundary. It is important to note that there is no restrictions on enrolling the following:

- Families that reside within our school boundary
- Children that already have a sibling at the school.

We have established a waiting list for families that do not have a sibling at the school or reside outside of our boundary.



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The number of families we accept from outside our boundary will be determined late in Term 3 (once we have a greater understanding of the number of siblings that will be joining us next year and the number of students that live within our boundary).

### Final few weeks of Term Two!

As we head into the final few weeks of Term Two, I just wanted to share some of the things that will be happening to ensure everyone is up to date with what is going on. This includes:

- **Planning Days** – in the second last week of every term, teachers are released for one full day to work with their team to reflect on the past 10 weeks and to prepare a plan for the coming term.
- **Parent Teacher meetings 28<sup>th</sup> of June.**  
General details about interviews include:
  - Meetings start from 1:00pm
  - Students stay at school for the whole day and will be dismissed at 3:15pm (normal time).
  - Interviews will be held in your child's classroom. Students will be supervised in the gym and library, and other available rooms by the leadership team and specialist staff.
  - Parents select an interview time online. Details of how to do this and when access will be available will be sent home in the coming weeks.
- **Student reports** to be sent home on 23<sup>rd</sup> of June
- **Final day of Term 2 is the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2017**
